

Mayor Woodby introduced Lisa Tipton and Robin Ledford of Families Free which is a program of inpatient rehab for non-violent crimes. They have a five-year lease agreement serving nine counties. Most counties have used the Opioid Settlement for their part of funding the program. They are asking Greene County to pay \$600,000 over a three-year period for Mayor Morrison to be a member of the board, they cover liability insurance on the treatment services with the state retaining some of the liability responsibility. Judge Rice informed the committee that their hope is the Department of Corrections will take over program funding. Concerns of how many spots would be available for Greene County since the spots would be divided with nine counties and the ongoing funding of the facility. Mayor Morrison recommends to do due diligence and if the Commission desires to join, it could be budgeted in the category of contributions July 1. Committee did not feel like they had enough information to make a decision in January.

Teddy Lawing recommended to the committee to fund Anti-Drug Coalition \$37, 500 now and then in put \$37,500 in the budget for school programs that the LEAD program may not reach. Danny recommended including the funding in the budgeting process to fund for an entire year. Recommendation would be taken to School Board by SRO's. Commissioner Peters recommended to have someone from the Anti-Drug Coalition to be at the January Budget Meeting.

Motion was made by Commissioner Burkey and seconded by Commissioner Quillen to approve budget amendment for Building and Zoning transfers. Motion carried with no opposition.


